PROBABLE CAUSE AND FACTS OF ARREST

On 05/08/09 at approximately 0347 hours an armed robbery occurred at 1601 US HWY 165 South, Wossman Shell, Monroe, La. During the robbery the store attendant was shot. A witness saw the suspects flee the scene in a blue GM truck and gave responding officers a description. Video surveillance at the store also captured the crime in progress. MPD Cpl. Bauer saw a truck matching the suspect vehicle description on US HWY 165 and affected a traffic stop. Upon stopping the vehicle three males, George A. Lee, Anthony E. Bradshaw, and Benjamin B. Ware were in the vehicle. Bradshaw and Ware matched the physical and clothing description of the suspects. As the officers were removing them from the vehicle a translucent bag was seen on the floor of the backseat. The officers could see that the bag contained money in it. Further search of the vehicle revealed two handguns inside of the vehicle and items that were used to conceal the suspects' faces during the robbery. Lee, Bradshaw, and Ware were taken into custody and transported to MPD. After being advised of his rights per Miranda Lee admitted to being at Wossman Shell but denied any knowledge of the robbery or shooting. Lee was the driver of the vehicle and was not inside the store at the time of the robbery. Lee stated that Bradshaw and Ware went into the store alone and returned to the vehicle several minutes later. Ware was carrying the bag which was later found to contain the money. Lee also denied any knowledge of the firearms in the truck.
